in the Republic of Vietnam. First Lieutenant Westbrook distinguished himself while serving as a Platoon Leader with Company C, 1st Battalion, 22nd Infantry, 4th Infantry Livision. On 31 May 1968, while pursuing a mission, Company C crossed a river near bak To. As the company crossed the swollen river b means of a rope, one member lost his hold and began to drift downstream. Lieutenant Westbrook immediately saw that he was in serious danger due to the strong current and weight of his pack. With complete disregard for his safety, he divedinto the swift river and with the aid of a comrade pulled the drowning man to safety. First Lieutenant Westbrook's extraordinary courage, outstanding performance, and exemplary devotion to duty are in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflect great credit upon himself, his unit and the United States Army.
